Day 1:

Upon your arrival in Las Vegas you will pick up your rental vehicle and transfer to the MGM Grand Hotel and Casino. This afternoon golf will be arranged at Royal Links Golf Course.

Overnight at MGM Grand Hotel and Casino.

Day 2:

This morning golf will be arranged at Badland Golf Course.

Overnight at MGM Grand Hotel and Casino.

Day 3:

This morning golf will be arranged at Las Vegas National Golf Course.

Overnight at MGM Grand Hotel and Casino.

Day 4:

This morning golf will be arranged at TPC at the Canyons Course.

Overnight at MGM Grand Hotel and Casino.

Day 5:

Today you will depart Las Vegas.

Las Vegas Hotels

New York, New York

Opened in 1997, the New York -New York has 12 New York City-styled hotel towers extending 47 stories (1/3 the actual size of New York City architecture) and is the tallest hotel/casino in Nevada. A 150 foot replica of the Statue of Liberty and 300 foot long Brooklyn Bridge walkway in the front of the hotel is featured.



Luxor Hotel & Casino

Luxor Hotel and Casino is located on the Las Vegas "Strip", across from the Tropicana and a Monorail ride to the Excalibur. The Luxor has 4,474 luxurious rooms and suites in a Egyptian motif, which are reachable in the unbelievable inclinator (elevators) that travel upward at a 39 degree angle. All the rooms either have a view of the beautiful surrounding mountains or the famous "Strip".

Caesar's Palace

Here you'll find a world resplendent in regal pleasures. It is the zenith of impeccable service, lavish accommodations, exquisite cuisine, splendid recreational opportunities, magnificent entertainment, and championship sporting events.

Riviera Hotel & Casino

The hotel is located on the "Strip", 3 1/2 miles from Las Vegas McCarran International Airport, 3 miles from downtown and 3 blocks from the Las Vegas Convention Center. The Riviera's newly renovated 2,100 deluxe rooms and suites provide first class accommodations at off-season rates. Most of the rooms feature refrigerators, hair dryers, and floor safes.

The Bellagio Hotel and Casino

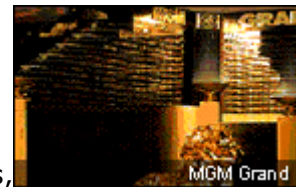
Bellagio brings a new level of elegance, grace, and romance to Las Vegas. This Mirage Resorts property adds an entirely new dimension to the world-renowned destination, Las Vegas.

Bellagio is located at the corner of Flamingo and Las Vegas Boulevard, the heart of "the Strip." Throughout the resort, guests enjoy sweeping vistas of a magnificent lake, classical gardens, and European fountains and pools. The resort design was inspired by the idyllic village of Bellagio, which overlooks Italy's Lake Como. Bellagio's entrance statement is a 12-acre lake with fountains that dazzle guests with a choreographed ballet of water, music, and lights. The display takes place several times a day.



MGM Grand

Dubbed "The City of Entertainment," this mega hotel certainly lives up to its name. Four entertainment venues host everything from championship boxing to legendary headline entertainers, to top comedians. The Grand Theatre is the home of the \$45-million stage extravaganza EFX. The hotel's casino - the equivalent of four football fields in size - offers slot machines, table games, video games, keno, poker, and a race and sports book. The Grand Pool and Spa complex is set in a lavish environment with five pools, lush landscaping, a river, bridges, fountains, and waterfalls. The Grand Spa features state-of-the-art cardiovascular and weight training equipment along with a multitude of personal treatments including massages, scrubs, and facials. The hotel features 10 signature restaurants, three of which are managed by celebrity chefs. Several casual restaurants and a fast-food court are also available. The hotel is home to an eclectic group of stores that are sprinkled throughout its cavernous interior. Eight championship golf courses are found nearby and can be used by guests for an additional fee.



Fairfield Inn

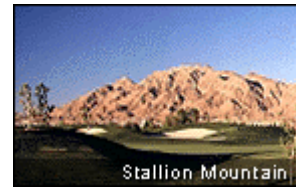
The Las Vegas Fairfield Inn is located only 1 mile east of the world famous Las Vegas Strip and only 2 miles north of McCarran International Airport. The Fairfield Inn features a heated outdoor swimming pool and whirlpool, and offers complimentary airport transportation from 6:00am until 11:00pm.



Las Vegas Golf Courses

Stallion Mountain

Stallion Mountain Country Club is a premier private golf destination in Las Vegas. The North Course is classified as a traditional championship tract, with large bent grass greens, wide fairways and numerous sand and water hazards. The course is player friendly, providing scratch players as well as average players an ultimate game of golf. The South Course is classified as a traditional championship tract, with large bent grass greens, wide fairways and numerous sand and water hazards. The West Course is classified as a traditional championship tract, with large bent grass greens, wide fairways and numerous sand and water hazards. The signature hole is number 17, Sudden Death, a beautiful par three which forces water carrier shot to the green.



Angel Park

Angel Park Golf Club offers two highly acclaimed 18 hole championship golf courses and are the centerpieces of this golf paradise. The Mountain Course is desert golf at its finest. Winding through the rolling natural terrain and skirting dense stands of native vegetation, this course is at an elevation of 2,800 feet and features panoramic views of the Spring Mountains, Red Rock Mountains and the Las Vegas skyline that are simply spectacular. The Palm Course requires plenty of distance off the tees and finesse around the undulating greens, however the course's receptive fairways and multiple tee placements keep it from overwhelming beginning and intermediate players.



Desert Pines

Desert Pines Golf Club is lined with towering mature pines set against the beautiful backdrop of the Las Vegas skyline and nearby mountains. Over 3,000 specimen pine trees were planted and bales of pine needles were imported, creating a true pine forest in the desert! Beautiful water features come into play on 9 of the holes.



The Royal Links

Royal Links is a tribute to the birthplace of golf-Scotland, Ireland and Britain. The course will feature 18 holes inspired by the most famous golf courses in the world. Courses such as Royal Lytham, Royal Troon, Prestwick, Royal Liverpool, The Old Course at St. Andrews, Royal Birkdale, Royal St. George, Muirfield, Turnberry and Carnoustie have all contributed to the design of this course.



Legacy

The Legacy Golf Club at Green Valley is a course destined to confront the most sophisticated golf enthusiast. The course features several holes rated as Las Vegas' best. The famed "Devil's Triangle" will offer challenge and fun, as well as "Suits" and "Love Grass". This course is enhanced by native surroundings which include love grass and lava rock.



Las Vegas Paiute Resort

The two courses, Snow Mountain and Sun Mountain at the Las Vegas Paiute Resort are nestled amongst wild flowers and a landscaped sea of warm browns and dusty olives that create an oasis of colorful boundaries that separate each hole. Sun Mountain was the first master planned multi-course developed on Native American land.

Painted Desert

Painted Desert Golf Club is the first of the Las Vegas desert courses and has numerous contrast of the desert areas and lush green fairways that lends beauty and challenge to the experience. Painted Desert's tee boxes and fairways are separated by native desert vegetation (cactus and mesquite), several lakes guard the landing areas and greens, and many bunkers dot the course.



Wild Horse

Wildhorse Golf Club is a traditional layout with hundreds of trees, several glimmering water hazards and greens flanked by strategic bunkering.

Las Vegas National

The Las Vegas National Golf Club is a traditional, oasis styled golf course with thousands of trees which place a premium on ball position.

Lake Las Vegas Reflection Bay

Lake Las Vegas is sculpted from the desert's rugged natural contours and framed by the crystal blue water of Nevada's largest privately owned lake. Natural splendor of Lake Las Vegas Resort (Reflection Bay) colors the quality of life here. It starts with the lush greens of the course themselves. The course is set against the quiet beauty of the rugged natural terrain, the crystal blue water framed by many of the courses challenges and highlights the majesty of the lake itself.



Las Vegas Sightseeing

Boulder City/Hoover Dam Museum

Dedicated to the preservation of historical artifacts relating to the workers and construction of the Hoover Dam. Sponsored by the Boulder City Historical Association. Free 20-minute movie screening "Construction of Hoover Dam" containing original movie footage from the construction.

Casino Legends Hall of Fame

Located in the Tropicana Hotel you can see the world's largest collection of Nevada casino memorabilia. Everything that made Las Vegas the legend it is, is reflected here in photos, coins, gaming tokens, old slot machines, decks of cards and out-dated dice.

The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace

Although predominantly a place to shop and dine, this indoor mall has a few unique attractions to offer as well. Foremost are the animated statues and laser show at the center pavilion. "Statue Animations" are about every half hour and are nearly unbelievable (or should we say believable). Watch Bacchus come to life and chat amongst the other gods and goddesses while above you a fantastic laser light show brings the ceiling to life too. The newest attraction is the free Atlantis show outside the new IMAX Theatre. Here you can watch a tale of Atlantis rise from the sea and as the Gods decreed sink back to the ocean bottom and afterwards venture into the IMAX for an Atlantis oriented thrill ride. Also while there, keep an eye on the sky-like ceiling which very subtly changes from dawn to dusk over the course of about a half an hour. Great arcade (downstairs at the far end) for kids, a magic shop with constant demonstrations and one of the largest FAO Schwartz toy stores.

Elvis-A-Rama Museum

Located behind the Fashion Show Mall, this unique museum pays tribute to the "King", Elvis Presley. Over \$3 million of Elvis memorabilia will captivate your attention. Get a glimpse of the 35kt red star ruby ring and the many costumed designed Hollywood movie outfits he wore or even his fantastic automobiles and first ski boat. The 80-foot long Elvis-a-rama mural by renowned artist Robert Shappy is the world's largest tribute to this famous Las Vegas legend. A special treat for visitors is when Tim Welch comes on stage singing Elvis' hit songs in true Presley style! A huge gift shop offers everything "Elvis", including a photo opportunity with Rusty Wallace's NASCAR showcar, featuring Elvis on the hood.
